### Post 16

Our post 16 provision focuses on preparing our students for adulthood. The curriculum is delivered 1:1 and personalised to students interests, their needs, personal development and aspirations for the future. Learning intentions are closely linked to their EHCP outcomes. All lessons have cross curriculum links which reinforces and consolidates learning and understanding. Students are provided with work opportunities and educational experiences to explore their employability pathways and focus on independence. Students currently study entry level functional skills and ASDAN courses relevant to their interests, which include short course maths, English, gardening, personal development, and transforming aspirations. Students are read to and read everyday independently.

Students experience enrichment activities which include visiting National Trust places of interest, weekly sessions at the local gym and community work experiences on the school site and within the wider community. Educational provision for post 16 students is based in a small house on the school site which provides extended opportunities for students to explore independent living skills such as managing money, keeping themselves safe, making friends and being part of the local community and society as a whole. Travelling on local transport, visiting the hairdressers are all activities experience by our post 16 students. Weekly sessions at the local gym and preparing healthy meals supports skills for independent living and staying healthy.
