Key Stage 4

Our Key Stage 4 provision focuses on preparing our students for their next step in their education. The curriculum is delivered 1:1 and personalised to students interests, their needs, personal development and aspirations for the future. Students follow a more formal curriculum, studying Maths and English Skills up to Level 1 or GCSE, whichever is more appropriate for the student. We believe that students benefit from a broad curriculum that improves engagement by developing knowledge and skills through immersive topic based learning which continues with both 'big questions' and the termly class book which supports the English area of study. Students are supported to develop a person centred ASDAN qualification portfolio. All students experience learning outside the classroom through Horticulture lessons. Preparing healthy meals, weekly visits to the gym and enrichment experiences provide an enhanced curriculum to further develop students personal development and to prepare students for adulthood. Students are provided with work opportunities and educational experiences to explore their employability pathways and focus on independence.

Students experience enrichment activities which include visiting National Trust places of interest, and work experiences on the school site and within the wider community. Educational provision for Key Stage 4 students is based in a small house on the school site which provides extended opportunities for students to explore independent living skills such as managing money, keeping themselves safe, making friends and being part of the local community and society as a whole.
