

Visitor Safeguarding Information

All Visitors to Hope House School must report to Reception on arrival.

- Please sign in and wear your visitors' lanyard.
- You will be told if there is a Fire Drill planned.
- The disabled toilets are in the south block.
- Personal mobile telephones must be kept on silent and should be kept securely.
- We are a non-smoking site – This includes vaping.
- You must not have any smoking/vaping equipment on your person.
- Any food must be consumed in the dining room.

Visitor Procedures

Once you have signed in at Reception, you are asked to remain in the waiting area until your host comes to collect you.

Health & Safety

A safe working environment is essential, and all visitors are expected to co-operate to ensure the high standards at our site are maintained.

Accidents & Incidents

Report all accidents, incidents, or near-misses to your host. If you require first aid treatment, please speak to your host, or contact Reception immediately.

Emergency Procedures

If you should hear the fire alarm, leave the building through the nearest fire exit and make your way to the grassed area outside the Cosy Room. Please remain with your host at all times. To raise the alarm please press one of the fire alarms around the site.

Confidentiality

All matters relating to Hope House School are confidential. Phones are expected to be switched off during meetings and photography is strictly forbidden unless prior arrangement has been agreed.

Smoking and the use of mobile phones are prohibited on the school site.

All medicines should be kept in a secure place at all times and under no circumstances should be administered to children.
